

Transporting a Gas Refrigerator

If the unit cannot be transported upright, lay it on one of its sides, preferably with the burner side (left side as you are standing in front of the unit) facing down. When the unit is eventually positioned vertically for operation, the refrigerator will not require "burping."

If transporting on any other side, "burp" the unit when at the final destination before operation. "Burping" can be accomplished by one of the following:

- 1) Tilt the unit to the left to about a 45-degree angle and hold for 2-3 minutes. Then tilt to the right to about a 45-degree angle and hold for 2-3 minutes.
- 2) Completely turn the unit upside down and let sit for approximately 15 minutes. Turn the unit back to normal position and let sit for approximately 15 minutes prior to lighting.

NOTE -- When turning the unit, turn from side to side, not front to back.
